## STRUCTURE OF CERTIFICATE OF HIGHER EDUCATION: ART AND DESIGN 120 CREDITS IN TOTAL

The Certificate comprises 120 credits NQFW4 of which 70 credits must be taken from the key modules. The Tutorial module and the 3 key art history modules in bold are compulsory.

In order to obtain the certificate candidates must achieve a weighted average of at least 40% overall.

Students may not take more than 20 credits at Level 0. Modules are 10 credits unless otherwise stated.
